

GOLDEN WEST WATER POLO CLUB ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

As an authorized representative of GOLDEN WEST WATER POLO CLUB, and USA Water Polo, I will comply with the following guidelines.

1. The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products or controlled substances by any athlete is prohibited.
2. Curfews established by the coaches will be adhered to each day.
3. Team members and staff will attend all team functions including meetings, warm-ups, practices, competitions, meals, etc., unless otherwise excused or instructed by the coach of record.
4. To ensure the propriety of the athletes and to protect the staff, there will be no male athletes in female athletes' rooms, and no female athletes in male athletes' rooms.
5. Team members and staff will refrain from any illegal or inappropriate behavior that would detract from a positive image of GOLDEN WEST WATER POLO CLUB.
6. Team members will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, administrators, fellow competitors and the public.
7. Any additional guidelines for the team will be established as needed by the coach of record.
8. All CLUB members must act in a respectful and responsible manner while at our practice facility or any other location.

IMPLEMENTATION

- a. Your signature of the document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with GOLDEN WEST WATER POLO CLUB Code of Conduct.
- b. Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct as set forth in this document may result in disciplinary action.

Such discipline may include, but not be limited to:

1. Dismissal from the team and immediate return home (at the parents expense);
2. Disqualification from one or more games, or all events of competition;
3. Disqualification from future GOLDEN WEST CLUB events.
4. Financial penalties (return from games, lost entries, etc.)
